4. All earth - ly crowns shall turn to mold, All glit - t'ring pride and van - i - ty;

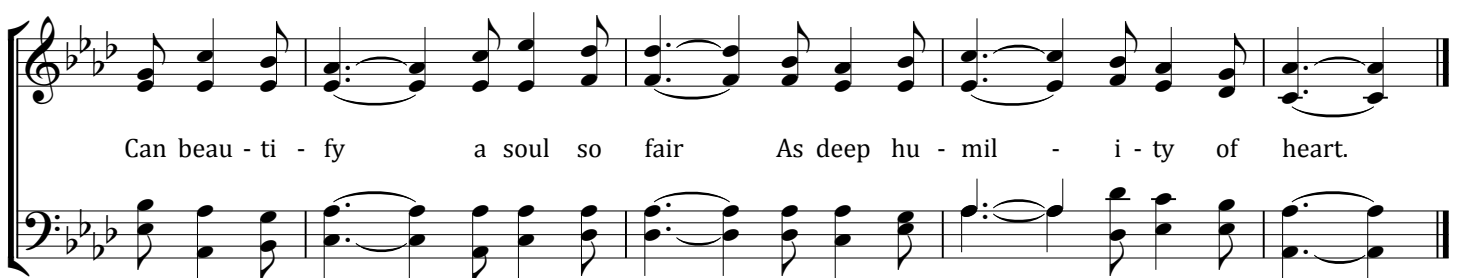


It is a meek and low - ly mind, The gem of pure hu - mil - i - ty.
